We're proposing to increase the annual navigation safety bylaw fee by \$22.71 (incl GST) per year for:

Amendments and changes proposed to fees, charges and policy

We are proposing amendments as follows:

- changing the amount of fee time from 30mins to one hour for providing information under the RMA
- minor amendments to account for changes to the RMA and Regional Plan rules
- adding a staff charge rate category for 'Group Manager/Harbour master'
- clarification around requests to change a consent holder name
- updates to annual charges for moorings and marina berths
- updating the fees structure for annual charges for coastal structures
- increasing pilotage and shipping navigation safety services fees by 5%.
